Number of Scholarships



Fifteen percent (15%) tuition discount to all full-time NYC employees who enroll in an associate's or bachelor's degree program offered through the Albertus Magnus College Division of Professional and Graduate Studies. Employees who are new or continuing students shall qualify for the tuition discount upon providing proof of employment. Acceptable documentation includes a letter from the NYC Human Resources Office, a copy of an employee ID, or a recent pay stub.

Twenty-five percent (25%) tuition discount to all NYC police officers, firefighters, 911 dispatchers, correction officers, and EMT employees, herein defined as first responders, on all programs offered through the Division of Professional and Graduate Studies.

This scholarship cannot be combined with any other tuition-based discounts or scholarships offered by the College. Acceptance to the school does NOT guarantee a scholarship.
