**No. 1:**        **IN THE MATTER** of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to utilize a different procedure, pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to enter into an amendment of the Sole Source License Agreement ("Agreement") with Statue Cruises, LLC for the operation and maintenance of passenger ferries for the purpose of embarking and discharging passengers on a regular schedule between The Battery, Liberty Island, and Ellis Island, and for the purpose of embarking and discharging passengers of vessels on sightseeing cruises and other ferry operations, which may include but are not limited to day and night charters of vessels, owned, operated or chartered by Statue Cruises, LLC at landing slips and adjacent walkways located in The Battery, Manhattan. The sole source agreement will extend the previous term by three (3) years so that it expires February 29, 2024, conterminously with the agreement between the National Parks Service and Statue Cruises.
