A collision at an intersection located on a precinct border may appear in the list of intersections of any precinct that shares that intersection, but will appear in only one precinct list. Collision location is captured as the nearest intersection.

A collision on a highway, bridge or tunnel which occurs at or near a precinct border may appear in the list of highways, bridges or tunnels of any precinct that shares that location, but will appear in only one precinct list. Collision location is captured as the nearest highway/bridge/tunnel reference/mile marker.
